# MILLI JANATKOVÁ V RYTMU





A multi-instrumentalist, composer, singer and visual artist, Milli Janatková is an eclectic artist who effortlessly interconnects artistic forms and genres from jazz and folk to world music and indie a capella. Based in the heart of Europe in the Czech Republic, she has visited countless places in Europe, Asia and North America. Apart from singing, she plays guitar, percussion, drums, and uses looping devices. Her music has been awarded the LIT Talent Music Awards, LIT Music of the Year, The Independent Music Awards (USA) and Classic Prague Awards (Crossover). She has produced and released four solo albums - Klid, prosím! (2022), Hluboko (2020), Mým kořenům (2017) and Proměna (2013). She also composed music for a Czech-Canadian project The Thieves of Dreams that has won the prestigious JUNO Award - Global Music Album (Canadian Grammy Award). In 2023 Milli was chosen from more than 200 Czech bands to present her music live in the Šance Muzikus Final and won the slots at Czech festivals as Sázavafest. She has been supported by the export office SoundCzech and Arts and Theatre Institute to be a part of Czech delegation at conferences abroad and on her creative tours and collaborations. Milli performed in three states of India (Mumbai Jazz Festival, Madras Jazz Festival, West Bengal festivals and clubs), Nepal (Nepal Academy of Fine Arts in Kathmandu) Denmark (Jødisk Kulturfestival in Copenhagen), France (Prague-Paris Jazz Club), Greece (Blackbox Jazz Festival Athens, Baccara Lefkada) and Germany (Kosmos Chemnitz Festival). Her projects support respect to our ancestors, balance, health and global responsibility.
